Removing litter from this area is so important. So, please get out there and remove what you can! Whether it's a handful or full bin bags, every piece of pollution that's removed will make a difference.

Reasons to take part

Clearing litter

- makes a place look nicer.
- allows the people who use the area to value and enjoy it more.
- protects animals and birds from injury and from ingesting toxins in plastic and other waste.
- enhances your wellbeing by being in the natural world and doing something beneficial for nature and other people.

Resources

You can collect a litter picking kit from the café, or use your own. We recommend bringing gloves, a litter picker, and a container, such as a bucket, for the rubbish. Please return the kit for us to clean after use.

Bin it!

Have a look through your haul and separate the litter into our recyclable and non-recycling bins.

Record
